

A FEW COMMON Q & A 'S FOR REFEREES

Q. Do I pull player passes when a red card is issued? (Rule 10.5.3)

A. Yes. Mail to CYS with a supplemental game report.

Q. Which team changes jerseys when there is a conflict?

A. The home team should wear a dark color & the visitor a light color. (See rule 10.4.5 and 10.4.6)

Q. When reporting a game the date, time, and field location are incorrect, can I change them?

A. The referee & AR's must change the game date, the other information cannot be changed & notification to CYS is not necessary.

Q. Only 2 officials showed up for a game, can we do a 2 man / 2 whistle system?

A. No. See rule 10.5.1

Q. A team forgot their passes & or roster, what should I do?

A. Let them play, see rule 10.5.2(d) for details.

Q. In the Elite Division how long are the halves?

A. 45 minutes for all Elite Division I & II games, and 40 minutes for Elite Division III (U15 & 16 teams only) games.

Q. Can I change or delete a report I have already made?

A. No. If you realize that you have made a mistake do not enter another report for the same game. Send an email to controller@coyouthsoccer.org or call CSYSA at 303-346-2777, extension 15.

Q. What if I report the wrong score?

A: Same as above.

Q. How do I know if my game reports were accepted?

A. Reports are downloaded nightly into our main computer system. Check the cardsite or the phone system the day after you reported them.

Q. When do I send a supplemental game report?

A. When you have issued a red card.

If only one or neither team shows up for a scheduled game.

If the game is suspended prior to completion.

If you postpone a game at the field prior to it starting.

To report special circumstances and / or events pertaining to a game.

To report serious injuries.

Note: An email containing the same information as the report form will suffice, but passes must be mailed to the CYS office.

Q. Where do I send Supplemental Game Reports?

A. Via email to advadmin@coyouthsoccer.org or controller@coyouthsoccer.org
Or via fax to 303-346-4842 or by mail to CYS.

Q. Are CYS team jerseys required to have sleeves?

A. No.

Q. When will the next recertification or new referee clinic be?

A. Visit the state referee committee web page at www.coreferees.org
or call 303-456-8810

Q. How do I report State Cup games?

A. Complete the game card and turn in to Cup officials at the field.

Q. How do I report recreational games?

A. Contact the home club.

Q. What if I cannot log in to the CYS cardsite or the phone system does not recognize my SSN?

A. New referees need to complete an IRS Form W 9 and forward to the CYS office in order to be added to the CYS referee database. Form will be available on CYS web site.

Q. How do I get paid?

A. Read the referee pay policy at www.coyouthsoccer.org. Actual pay dates are published seasonally.
