CANDIDATES RECEIVE:

3 ½ hours of instruction, a youth module workbook and a certificate of completion

USSF “E” COURSE

THE “E” LICENSE IS AN 18 HOUR COURSE DESIGNED AS AN INTRODUCTION TO 11 v 11 SOCCER. FOCUS WILL BE ON PLAYERS FROM THE AGES OF 9-12

Candidates must be 15 years of age

COURSE LENGTH:

18 HOURS
3 hours classroom
14 hours field instruction
1 hour take-home testing

TESTING/COURSE COMPLETION:

Candidates must complete a take-home examination and attend all sessions to obtain the “E” License

COST:

\$85 per candidate

CANDIDATES RECEIVE:

Candidate workbook, Success in Soccer Basic Training, Volume 1 book, Success in Soccer Coaching Notebook and a certificate of completion

USSF “D” COURSE

THE “D” LICENSE IS A 36 HOUR COURSE THAT EXPANDS ON THE TECHNICAL, TACTICAL AND METHODOLOGY INTRODUCED IN THE “E” COURSE. THIS CURRICULUM IS DESIGNED FOR COACHES WORKING WITH PLAYERS WHO ARE U13 AND OLDER.

PREREQUISITES:

Candidates must be 17 years of age and E License held for at least 1 year

COURSE LENGTH:

36 HOURS
6 hours classroom
28 hours field
2 hours take-home testing

TESTING/COURSE COMPLETION:

Candidates will complete a written test, video test, and a practical field test. Candidates must also attend all sessions to obtain the “D” License. Candidate will be assigned a grade of National “D”, State “D” or Fail at the completion of the course.

COST:

\$125 per candidate

CANDIDATES RECEIVE:

Candidate workbook, Success in Soccer Basic Training, Volume 2 book and a Success in Soccer Coaching Notebook. Successful candidates will also receive a certificate indicating they have completed the requirements for the National “D” or State “D”.

“D” UPGRADE COURSE

THE “D” UPGRADE COURSE IS DESIGNED TO GIVE CANDIDATES WHO WERE AWARDED A STATE “D” A CHANCE TO REVIEW THE CURRICULUM AND RETEST.

COURSE LENGTH:

10 HOURS
2 hours classroom
8 hours field

TESTING/COURSE COMPLETION:

Candidates will take a practical coaching examination.

\$30 per candidate

CANDIDATES RECEIVE:

Candidate workbook. Candidates who successfully retest and meet the requirements for a National “D” will receive a certificate.
